Jesus' sacrificial death models true love (v. 16). Hate equals murder, lacking eternal life; love acts with compassion, not mere words (v. 14-18).

Cain's murderous hate, driven by jealousy (v. 12),

 Mercy glues fellowship—love counters heresy's division.

 Truth assures hearts before God, despite condemnation (v. 19-20); obedience to His

 God's Spirit confirms mutual abiding with Him (v. 24). Mercy anchors believers to God's presence, sustaining
