tribulation time (Rev chapter 8). The last 3 trumpets ??? caused severe demonic activities on earth. (Rev chap 9 and 10). In this session, Revelation 9: 13-21, we focus on understanding the second terror released on the last day, which looked like a horse prepared for war, see Joel 2. These are the four commander demons who were chained together with their troops, over 200 million, at the great Euphrates river, which is at the Garden of Eden. They will be released on the last days to torment Christ-rejecting people.
