It contrasts the power of Jesus' name when used by authorized believers with the failure of those without His covering. **Overcoming Demonic Barriers to Blessings** (Acts 19:12-20) Miraculous Power: God performs miracles through touched items, healing the sick and expelling evil spirits, enabling the church to access spiritual blessings.

• Widespread Impact: The incident spreads fear in Ephesus, elevating Jesus' name. Believers confess sins, and sorcerers burn valuable
