In this session, John 11: 1-16, Jesus learnt about his friend Lazarus's sickness from

his sisters. He stayed for more days and then informed his disciples of his intention to go back to Judea, where he had previously been threatened with being stoned. Jesus spoke to his fearful disciples, encouraging them to be courageous and to accompany him to Judea to raise Lazarus and glorify God.
