Introduction

Matthew 10:16-42

In Matthew 10, Jesus sends His disciples out for the first time to practice and express the ministry of teaching, preaching, and

healing, in what can be considered a shortterm experience in ministry (STEM). He warns them of the opposition and persecution they will face on account of Christ. In this session, we will explore the dynamics of persecution for the disciples and how to respond biblically, while remaining steadfast in faith and trusting in God's protection.
